Hannes Wettstein was one of the foremost designers of the Swiss school. He worked in the fields of product design, corporate design, interior design and architecture. In addition to the furniture, lamps and home accessories for which he was best known, he also designed professional audio equipment and watches. His work has been produced by, to name a few, Cassina, Dada, Desalto, Fiam Italia, Molteni, Unifor, Sony and Audi. Among his more important architectural projects are the Grand Hyatt hotel chain in Berlin and the Swiss embassy in Washington D.C. Since 1991, he had enjoyed a successful academic career alongside his activities as a designer.
